### Catering

The restaurant is located in the catering tent on the east side of the boat dock. Our catering team looks forward to seeing you. The restaurant's opening hours will be posted in the Service Centre during the regatta. **Meals for participants are available by advance order only!** Water will be served in the tent in reusable cups or in water bottles you bring with you. Snacks and drinks for visitors will be available at a separate stand in the finish area.

## Regatta regulations

The provisions of the official regatta information always apply with priority.

## Crew changes, withdrawals, and late entries

You must submit crew changes, withdrawals and late entries online at [max.m-start.de](https://max.m-start.de). You can use any web browser for this purpose. Alternatively, you will find terminals in the service centre where you can also make your entries. Please have the username and password of the original registrant ready. Notwithstanding the Rules of Racing and the German Rules of the Rowing Competition, the deadlines according to the official regatta information shall apply.

## Results service

Our automated results service is available at the terminals in the service centre. There you can send the official results by e-mail. In addition, they are available on the internet at [max.m-start.de](https://max.m-start.de)

For sustainability reasons, we do not print out start lists or results for teams.

## Weighing

All light weights are weighed according to the German rules and regulations (RWR) of the German Rowing Federation.

ATTENTION! The scale is located at the end of the administration building. Please use the entrance on the waterfront side. You must bring a photo ID with you to use the scale. Test weighing is available there on Friday from 2:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

## Team Managers Meeting

There will be no Team Managers Meeting. Please contact the service centre for more information.

## Bow numbers

All boats must be provided with bow numbers. These will be issued at the service centre before the start for a deposit of 10 Euro and must be returned there after the race.

## Racing attire

Please refer to paragraph 2.6.7 of the AWB / Rule 39 World Rowing Rules of Racing regarding racing attire.

## Training times

Training at the track is possible as follows: Friday to Sunday from sunrise until 30 minutes before the first race and 30 minutes after the last race until sunset.

## Start

A boat may not enter the start zone until it is clear for which race it has been assigned and the Starter has assigned a starting lane to the boat. The boats must be at their starting positions two minutes before the starting time. The instructions of the Starter and the jury in general must be followed. The Starter may start the race without regard to absentees and may caution a boat crew arriving late to their starting position.

## Team tents

Tents, which serve the teams' stay, can be set up along the course in the designated areas free of charge after registration at the service centre. A corresponding area will be allocated by the regatta management,

there is no entitlement to a special place. The preparation of meals is not permitted in these team tents. Open fires (charcoal/gas) are prohibited.

## Supply tents

A flat-rate fee will be charged for tents used to supply one's own team:

- In advance 100 €
- On site 125 €

Bookings are possible via the online entry system.

## Arrival

Visitors who arrive and park on the grounds before May 8 are expressly advised that official entry and access will not be permitted until May 8. Vehicles, trailers, and boats that are parked on the grounds before May 8 without instructions from Regatta München must expect to be repositioned on May 8.

## Boat storage

The storage of the boats is at the risk of the clubs. In case of possible damage, there is no legal claim against the organiser or the host.

## Access to the venue

- **Towing vehicles** may enter the premises with a trailer and unload the boat trailers. They must then leave the premises within 30 minutes and may park in the grandstand parking lot. For this, they need a parking permit, which must be ordered in advance via the online registration system. Unloaded boat trailers must be parked in the boat trailer parking lot, not in the boat launch area.
- **Tour buses** may enter the grounds and park immediately to the left after the entrance. No parking pass is required for this. However, space for tour buses is limited. Tour buses must therefore be registered in advance at [info@regatta.de](mailto:info@regatta.de).
- **Team/club vehicles** are not permitted to enter the grounds but may park in the grandstand parking lot, which has direct access to the boat area. The parking lot is subject to a fee and is operated by an external contractor. Parking passes are subject to a fee (€15 for the entire event). See "[Parking permits.](#)"
- **Other visitor vehicles** may park on-site in the grandstand parking lot but must pay their parking fees at the payment machine or via the designated app, depending on the duration of their stay. For vehicles without payment made online or at the payment machine, the parking lot operator will charge the owner 40 euros (60 euros for non-German residents) and enforce collection.

## Parking permits

New this year, the external parking operator has introduced license plate recognition for the grandstand parking lot. As a result, parking tickets are no longer required for the grandstand parking lot. Instead, the license plates of all vehicles must be registered in advance. The registration link will be made available early next week and sent to the representatives who have ordered a parking ticket.

A parking pass costs €6/day or €15 for all 3 days in the entry system MAX and includes unlimited entries and exits per day from 12:00 AM to 11:59 PM.

Please note: If you do not order a parking pass through MAX, you must pay separately on-site for each parking session via the parking operator's online portal or at the payment machine at the grandstand parking lot. In this case, the cost is €1 per hour, up to a maximum of €8, depending on entry and exit times and duration of stay. Vehicles without a valid registered license plate and without payment online or at the

payment machine will be charged €40 (€60 for non-German vehicles) by the parking operator, which will be enforced against the vehicle owner.

Registrations for €6/day or €15 for all 3 days can also be purchased on-site at the Service Centre in exceptional cases.

### Driving regulations on the premises

During the competition days, access to the boating area is strictly prohibited. Please park your trailers only in the specially designated parking spaces behind the boat halls and keep the access roads and all escape and rescue routes clear. Please understand that we will repeatedly ask you if you violate this regulation. We would also like to point out that in extreme cases we may exclude you from the event.

Walking, running, cycling and inline skating are prohibited on the grandstand-side waterfront road on competition days. Please inform your athletes! Coaches can accompany their rowers on the opposite shore road.

### Grandstand

Unfortunately, the grandstand is closed for fire safety reasons. Spectators can watch the races in front of the grandstand and on the opposite side of the finish tower at the small open grandstand.

### Regatta proceedings and award ceremony

The course length for JF/JM A is 2000 metres, for JF/JM B 1500 metres.

Basically, six lanes are started at intervals of four minutes. This may be deviated from in the preliminary heats in accordance with the regatta information.

#### General procedure

For events 112, 113, 116, 117, 126, 127, 129 and 130, heats will be held and later the finals C (for more than 15 entries), B and A. The same applies on Sunday for events 240 to 243. All other events will be divided into divisions eligible to win one hour before the start of the race. The Saturday events will be considered as qualification for the Sunday events. This means that the divisions on Sunday will be set by the jury according to the placings on Saturday. In the event of equal placings, time will be the deciding factor. Those who did not start on Saturday with the same crew will automatically be placed in the last race on Sunday.

#### Award ceremonies

Apart from the heats and the B and C finals, award ceremonies will take place after all races.

#### Junior B

The winners of each race will receive an original "Regatta München Winner" water bottle or special "Winner Socks," as well as a medal. Only the first-place finishers in each race will be honored on the winners' pontoon immediately after their race. Due to the tight race schedule, the athletes will remain seated in their boats.

#### Junior A

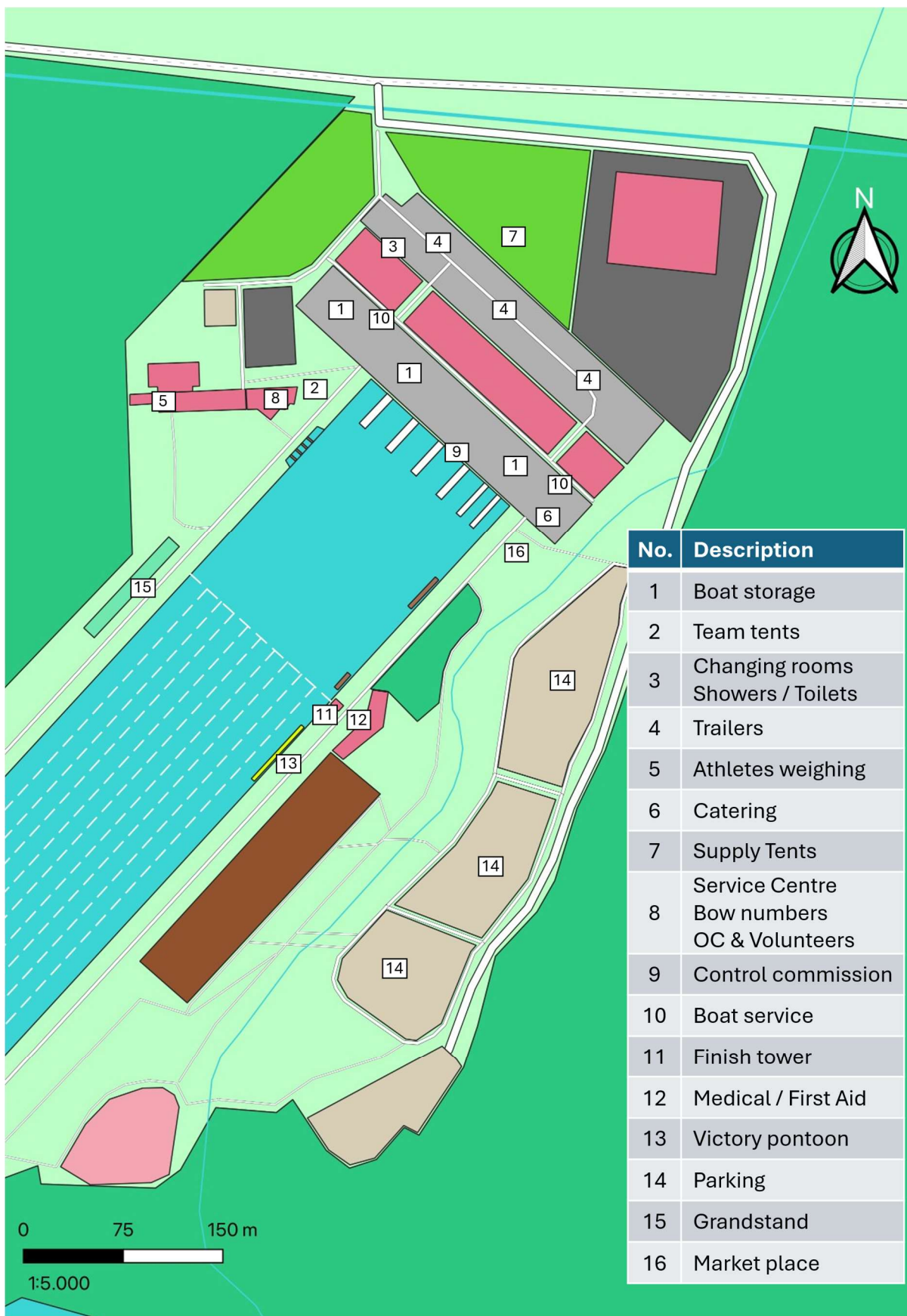
In races without heats, the winners receive an original "Regatta München Winner" water bottle or special "Winner Socks," as well as a medal. Only the first-place finishers in each race are honored on the winners' pontoon immediately following their race. Due to the tight race schedule, the athletes remain seated in their boats.

In races with heats, the top three finishers from the Final A races will be presented with their medals (gold, silver, and bronze) on the winners' podium. The first-place finishers will also receive an original "Regatta München Winner" water bottle or special "Winner Socks."

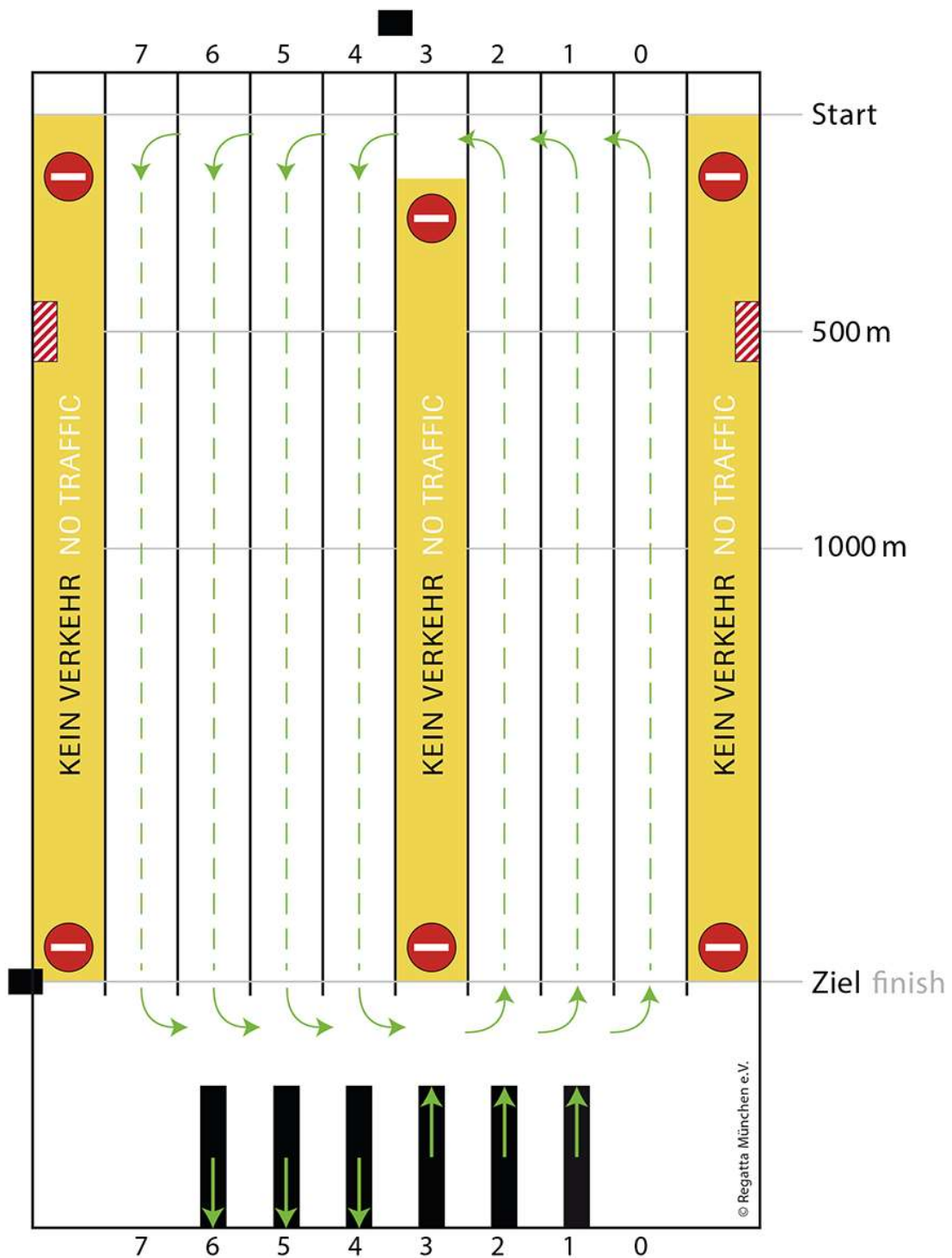
## Site plan



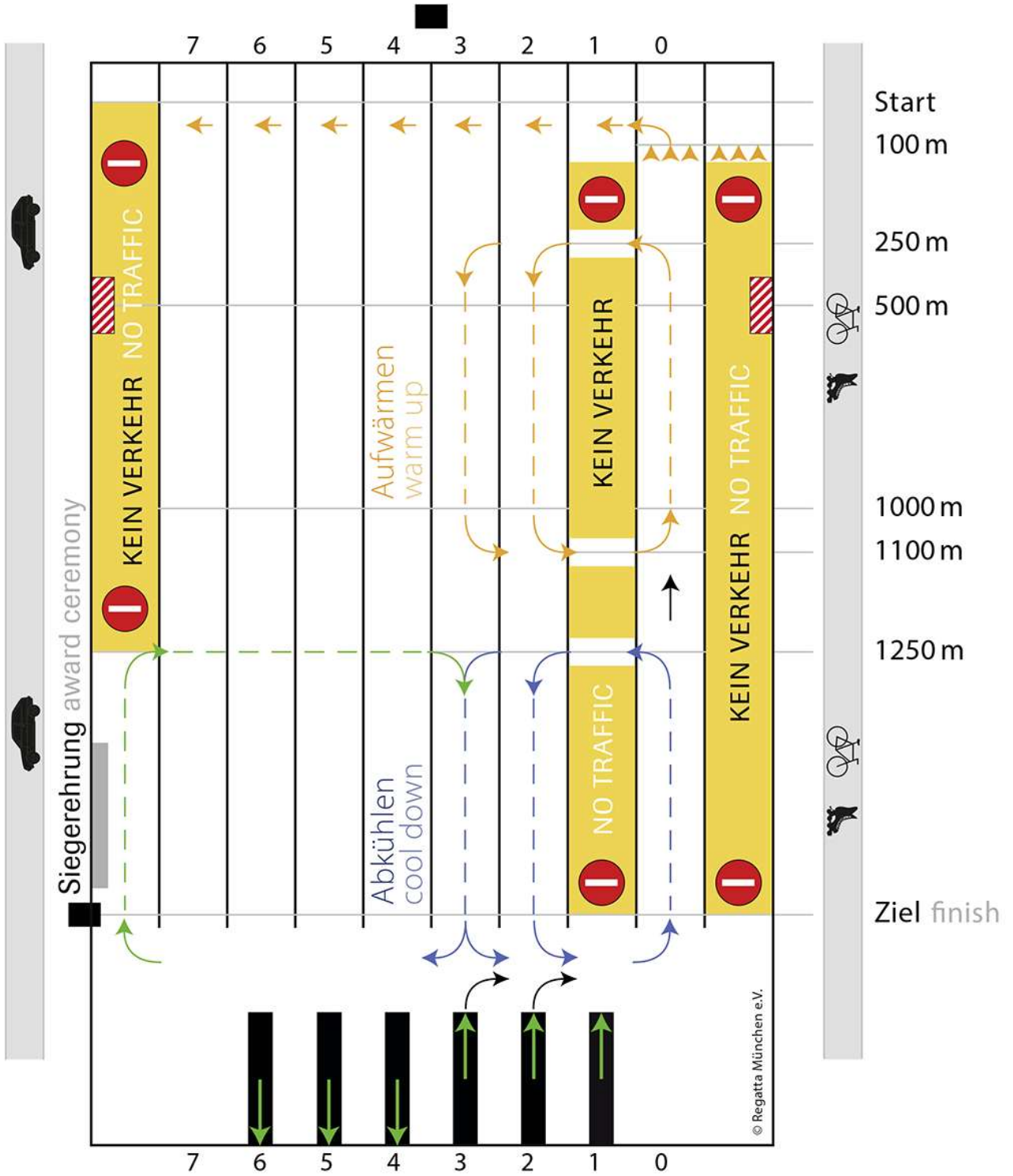
## Traffic rules

The traffic rules must be observed at all times, whereby we refer to the notice boards at the boathouse area and ask you to observe the safety regulations in this programme booklet. Violations will be punished with warnings. The start zone and finish line must be kept clear of boats not involved in an event. For safety reasons, the warm-up for 1500 meter Junior B events is explicitly NOT permitted in lanes 4 to 7.

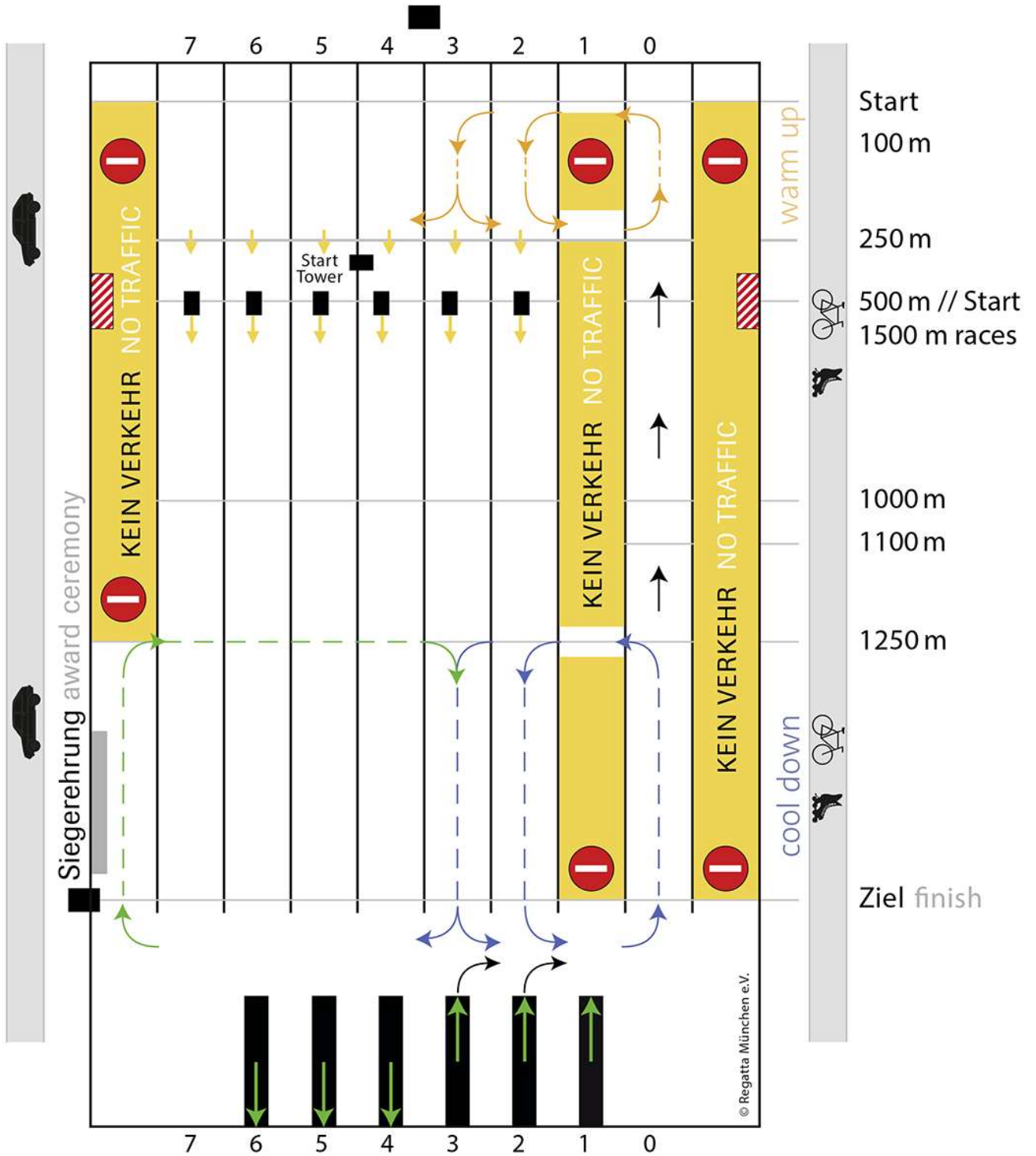
## Traffic Rules – Training
